

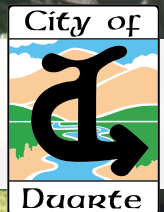

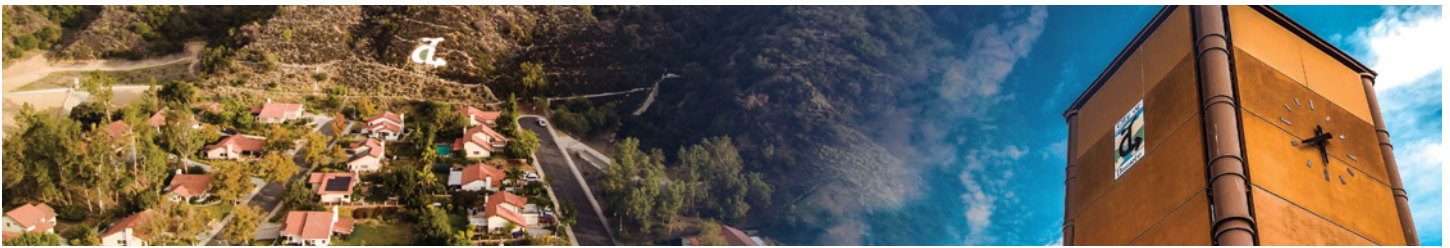

## Drive-Thru Dog Vaccination & Licensing Clinic



Saturday, June 18, 2022

### Dog Licensing Fees:

One Year, unaltered **\$60**

One Year, spayed/neutered **\$25**

Senior citizens, 65 years and older, are eligible for one free dog license if the pet is spayed or neutered.

**Avoid late fees and purchase your license by August 31, 2022. Rates including penalty after August 31 are as follows: One Year, unaltered \$120, One Year, spayed/neutered \$85.**

In cooperation with VET CARE, the Duarte Public Safety Office has scheduled the annual, low-cost Vaccination Clinic on Saturday, June 18 from 8 - 10 AM. The clinic will be held at Encanto Park, 777 Encanto Parkway; all attendees are required to stay in their vehicles and are highly encouraged to wear face coverings/masks during the event. Rabies vaccinations will be available for \$12 each, microchip registration for \$35, and other vaccinations will also be available upon request. In addition, participants can purchase Duarte dog licenses, which need to be renewed each year. Only check or credit, NO CASH.

Remember, all dogs over the age of four months must be vaccinated for rabies to comply with state law. Don't hesitate...Vaccinate!

If you cannot make this event, you may purchase your license by mail, at Duarte City Hall, or the Public Safety Office. For more information, please call Duarte Public Safety at (626) 357-7938.

## Duarte City Council Adopts New District Map, Completes Redistricting Process

At its meeting on Tuesday, April 12, the Duarte City Council completed the redistricting process and established a new City Council district map by adopting Ordinance No. 909 approving Map 103 Revised.

City Council seats for Districts 1, 4, 5, and 6 will be up for re-election this November, while the election in Districts 2, 3, and 7 will occur in November 2024. The new Council District map pairs Mayor Margaret Finlay and Mayor Pro Tem Tzeitel Paras-Caracci in District 1. It also pairs Councilmembers Jody Schulz and Vinh Truong in District 3. Two of the new Districts - District 2 and District 4 - have no incumbent Councilmembers.

The City began the redistricting process in September 2021 and hired National Demographics Corporation (NDC) as the demographer. Early in the process, Duarte created a dedicated redistricting website ([drawduarte.org](http://drawduarte.org)), which is a one-stop-shop for all matters Duarte redistricting. It provides education about the redistricting process, answers to frequently asked questions, a schedule of upcoming meetings, a contact us page, a subscription form to receive districting news, and mapping tools. Residents also had the ability to pick up paper map kits from City Hall and the Senior Center to submit hand-drawn submissions.

To gather public input and insights on the district formation process, the City Council held six Public Hearings, a Special Meeting, and a Regular Meeting:

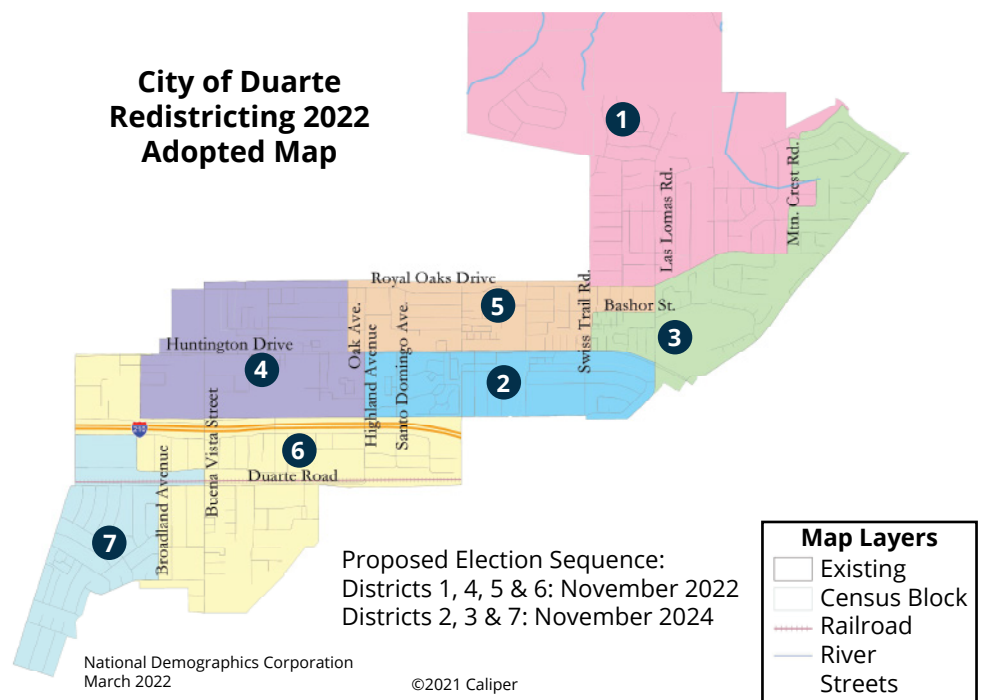
- **Public Hearing #1** - September 28, 2021: Identify neighborhoods, communities of interest, and secondary areas; mapping tools overview

- **Public Hearing #2** - January 11, 2022: Identify neighborhoods, communities of interest, and secondary areas; mapping tools overview
- **Public Hearing #3** - February 8, 2022: First presentation of maps and discussion of election sequence
- **Public Hearing #4** - February 28, 2022: Review draft maps and identify a preferred map
- **Public Hearing #5** - March 8, 2022: Discuss and consider draft maps; identify a preferred map
- **Public Hearing #6** - March 22, 2022: Discuss and consider draft maps; identify a preferred map
- **Special Meeting #7** - April 4, 2022: Second presentation of maps and

first reading of the ordinance to adopt the preferred map and its election sequence

- **Regular Meeting #8** - April 12, 2022: Review of the selected map and second reading of the ordinance to adopt the preferred map and its election sequence

# Duarte City Council Considers ARPA Fund Allocation and Goals for FY 22-23

On April 26, the Duarte City Council held a workshop to discuss community priorities regarding the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds and on May 5, held a workshop to discuss budgeting for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23.

Council agreed to accept \$5.1 million in ARPA funds to pay for basic government operations, specifically public safety services. These ARPA dollars will free up City General Funds over the next two years, creating more opportunity for the City to pursue special projects that enhance quality of life in Duarte. The City Council will determine these projects through budgeting processes that call for community participation.

The proposed FY 22-23 budget covers standard operational budget priorities, as well as several projects delayed by the pandemic. The City projects 78 percent of General Fund expenditures will be kept in reserves, creating a surplus for the next fiscal year. This positions the City to meet basic funding needs for maintaining operations, while simultaneously equipping the City to handle unexpected emergencies and plan around community priorities.

Residents reported through special meetings and FlashVote surveys ([flashvote.com/Duarte](https://flashvote.com/Duarte)) that budget priorities should focus on public safety, homelessness and localized commerce. As such, the City outlined potential budget allocations for the following projects and services for FY 22-23:

- Sheriff's Contract for -public safety services to offset City General Funds
- Additional staff support to enhance the City's response to homelessness
- Several capital projects, carried over from FY 21-22 to FY 22-23, with projections of substantially increased construction costs due to market activity
- Supporting the Duarte Chamber of Commerce with startup costs related to a new farmers market that will be held on the Santa Teresita campus
- Economic revitalization assessments in the FY 22-23 budget for several locations throughout the City, including the southeast corner of Buena Vista and Huntington Drive

The Duarte City Council is scheduled to review and adopt the FY 23-23 budget at the City Council meeting on Tuesday, June 14. Residents can join City Council meetings in-person every 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month at the Duarte Community Center (1600 Huntington Drive). At this time, live streaming is unavailable, but a video of the meeting will be added to the City's website.



## New Hybrid Hydration Station Arrives at Encanto Park

The next time you stop at Encanto Park (751 Encanto Parkway) you may notice something different: a hybrid hydration station complete with a water bottle refill machine and water fountains—one for you and one for your pet! Now when you're on the go at Encanto, playing a game of basketball or on a walk along the trails, you can refill your water bottles for free.

The new hydration station, installed with funding from CalRecycle, also known as the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), is a testament to the City of Duarte's commitment to the environment and our community. Staying hydrated is important year-round, but especially during hot summer and fall months so be sure to use the station as the weather warms up.

The City used funding from CalRecycle's Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program. This is one of CalRecycle's funding programs, designed to help organizations establish local beverage container recycling and litter abatement projects.

# PUBLIC SAFETY

## Hook'd & Book'd

On March 9, 2022, at approximately 9:30 AM, Temple Sheriff's dispatch received a 9-1-1 call from the Duarte Starbucks. They reported that an African American male who is a known problematic transient exposed himself to customers in the drive-thru line. Starbucks management had asked the man to pull up his pants; however, he refused and used profanity while attempting to assault the manager with a broom.

When deputies responded, the suspect attempted to flee from deputies. As he ran away, he vandalized the patrol cars and made advancing movements toward the deputies while holding a metal pole with a blade at the end. In an attempt to de-escalate the situation, deputies used a stun bag on the suspect. Initially the suspect appeared to cooperate with instructions after being struck with the stun bag, but after a short moment, the suspect again ran away. Due to the erratic and assaultive behavior the suspect was displaying, the deputies requested additional personnel, including the Sheriff's Department helicopter. The suspect continued to delay the deputies by running away and eventually entering Smart and Final. Once inside, he began to shatter the glass doors and display cases with the metal pole he was holding. The deputies followed after the suspect where they deployed a taser. The use of the taser was effective, and the suspect was taken into custody. The suspect was arrested with seven separate charges that disturbed 13 victims.

## Neighborhood Watch Update

Property crimes in Duarte increased over eighteen percent in the first quarter of 2021, when compared to the same period last year.

Grand theft auto and catalytic converter theft have spiked the first part of the year and residents are encouraged to take proactive measures to avoid becoming a victim:

- Always lock your vehicle, take your keys, and set your alarm, even if at home or in your garage
- Never keep spare keys in or under your car or around your home
- Maintain a clean car and avoid keeping valuable items inside
- Park in well lit, heavily populated areas
- Make a copy of your registration and insurance, and keep them in your wallet or purse. Remove all forms of identification from your vehicle

- Do not leave garage door openers in parked vehicles
- Please talk to anyone doing work in your home and make sure they secure their vehicle

If you see suspicious persons or vehicles in your neighborhood, please make a note of the make/model/color of the car or description of the person(s) and always call in ANY and ALL suspicious activity to Temple Sheriff's Station at (626) 285-7171. If you feel unsafe call 9-1-1.

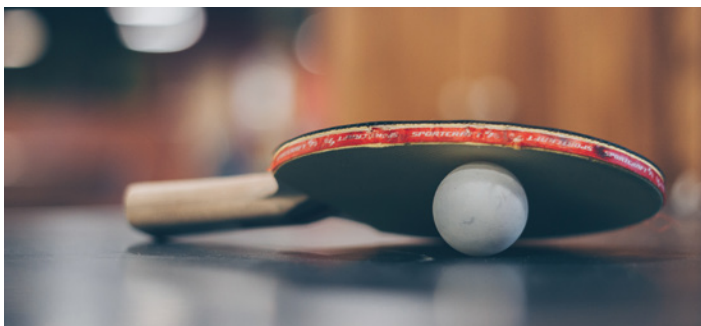

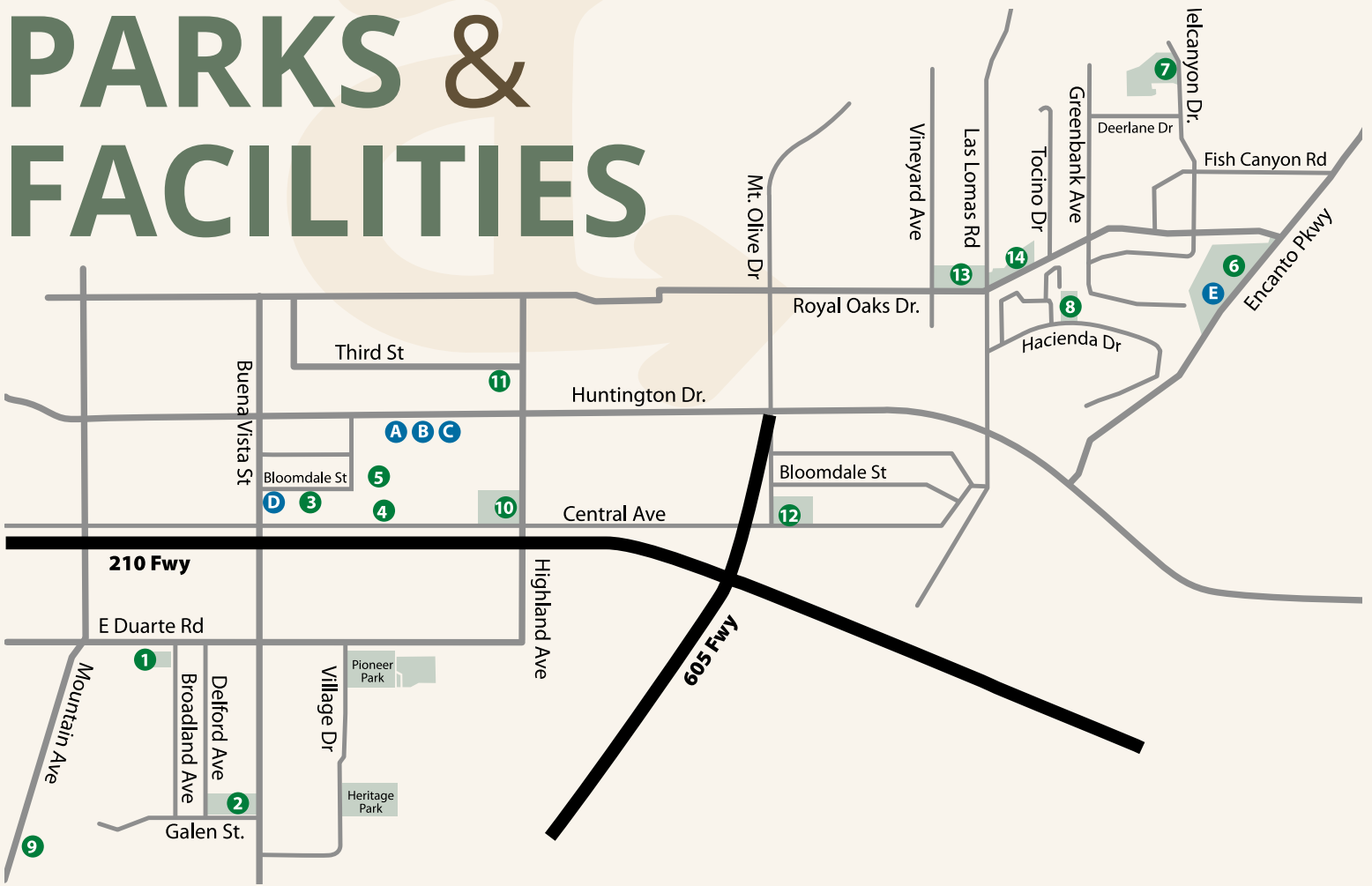
