

Commissioner Recruitment Opens November 23 for Newly Restructured City of Duarte Commissions

After several months of discussion on the Duarte City Commissions' structure and operations, the City Council approved the first reading of Ordinance No. 913 at their November 22nd Council meeting. The ordinance includes several modifications intended to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of Commissions in serving their community and providing recommendations to the City Council. In addition to changes to the Commissions structure, the City will be accepting applications for City Commissioners positions starting Thursday, November 23 through December 22.

Early last summer, City Councilmembers set goals and objectives for FY 2022-23 that included directing staff to conduct an analysis of the City Commissions' work as well as options for potential restructuring. The City Council's request grew out of a general consensus - among Councilmembers, City Staff, and City Commissioners – that opportunities existed for making the City Commissions more effective in carrying out their missions. After reviewing Commissioner agendas and minutes, attendance records, surveying Commissioners, and conducting interviews with Councilmembers, City Staff and Commissioners, City Manager Dan Jordan reported the results and potential restructuring options in a workshop on Tuesday, November 8. Through Council's discussion and further guidance, staff was directed to return with an ordinance for first reading.

Ordinance No. 913 includes the following modifications to the City Commissions:

- Reduces the number of Commissions from six to five by merging the current Economic Development Commission into the Planning Commission and creating a new Planning and Economic Development Commission.
- Standardizes the number of Commissioners on each City Commission at five members.
- Makes regularly scheduled Commission meetings every other month for each Commission except for the Planning and Economic Development Commission which will continue meeting on a monthly basis.
- Makes most "special" eligibility requirements for membership on specific Commissions optional rather than mandatory.

- Renames the current Public Services Commission to the Public Utilities, Communications, and Technology Commission.
- Renames the current Traffic Safety Commission to the Public Works and Traffic Safety Commission.
- Creates a framework within the Municipal Code to create, structure, and terminate Ad Hoc Committees.

The second reading of the ordinance will take place at the City Council on Tuesday, December 13. If approved, changes to the Commissions will go into effect beginning January 1, 2023.

The City of Duarte is now accepting applications for the newly structured Commissions. Most applicants must maintain a current residence in the City unless stated otherwise in the application, have no felony convictions, and provide a written resume in addition to the completed application. The application and Commission descriptions are available on the City's website at accessduarte.com/city-commissions. Deadline to submit is December 22, 2022, at 5 PM. Applications must be submitted in-person to the City Clerk's Office at 1600 Huntington Drive. For more information, please contact the City Clerk's office at (626) 357-7931, ext. 223.

City Ready to Launch New Filing Software

In an effort to increase transparency, the City of Duarte is implementing new software for the City's website: Laserfiche, a document management system, and NetFile, a campaign filing system. Both Laserfiche and NetFile will ensure all government-related documents are easily accessible to Duarte residents and will allow residents to find City records and information without having to submit a public records request. The public portals are set to go live in December 2022.

Through the Laserfiche public portal, Duarte community members will be able to search for City documents using the public portal link found at accessduarte.com/city-clerk. In the public portal, you can easily look up and view all City Council meeting minutes, City resolutions, ordinances, and contracts. The City is currently uploading items into the system in preparation for the launch before the end of the calendar year.

Duarte residents have the ability to view campaign filings via the NetFile public portal. Additionally, residents can use the tool to view and sort through election-related forms and find campaign financing information for any Duarte campaign or election. The NetFile public portal also removes the need to submit a public records request. The NetFile link can be found at accessduarte.com/city-clerk.

The City looks forward to providing easier access to City documents and election information through these two new public portals. Laserfiche and NetFile will aid the City and the Duarte City Clerk office's goal of promoting open government and encouraging efforts to increase transparency between local government and the Duarte community.

Neighborhood Watch Update

Year-to-date Part 1 crimes have increased by 11.52%, or 41 incidents, compared to last year. This uptick is attributed mainly to an increase in burglary, primarily commercial burglary, which rose by 65.71%. As a result, the City of Duarte and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department are working with businesses to take precautionary measures, and additional patrol has been deployed to help prevent burglaries. This winter, we ask residents to be vigilant about securing their property and take preventive measures.

Please follow the following tips:

- Lock your home and car and always use your alarm
- If possible, park in a garage, driveway, or well-lit area.
 Consider installing motion sensor lights If you have video surveillance, be sure they are facing entryways and cars and that your home is adequately lit, particularly in the evening
- Keep your car clear of all items and take all valuables home
- Prevent identity theft by removing documents with personal information from your vehicle and keeping your insurance and vehicle registration in your wallet.

 Anyone who engages in door-to-door solicitation must obtain a permit. Please do not open your door; let solicitors know you will call Temple Sheriff's Station (626) 285-7171 and allow Deputies to check their permit.

In this new assignment she will expand her knowledge of Duarte's Municipal Code and enforce city code and ordinances. She will also investigate and process resident and business complaints and prepare cases for court hearings.

She holds two Associate degrees from Pasadena City College in Natural Sciences and Humanities and is a Certified Animal Control Officer. In her spare time, she is an avid equestrian and competes in barrel racing.

Hook'd & Book'd

On September 4 at approximately 7:54 PM, Temple Sheriff's Station received a "911" call from an employee at VJ's Burger on Buena Vista Street who stated that a woman entered the restaurant with a bloody face. Deputies responded to the call and aided the woman who has been the victim of an assault. She stated that while walking through the parking lot of the restaurant a red 4-door Honda pulled alongside of her and an adult male Hispanic exited the car from the passenger seat and pointed a back semi-automatic handgun at her. The suspect hit her in the head several times with the handgun causing her injuries. The suspect fled the scene in the vehicle. Deputies investigated and determined the suspect was a known local gang member. The suspect was on Probation and Deputies conducted a compliance check as his residence. During the search Deputies recovered a Glock Black semi-automatic firearm. The suspect was arrested and charged with Assault with a deadly weapon, felon in possession of a firearm, possession of ammunition, and gang member in possession of a loaded firearm.
