 - Internet products coming soon: faster internet and automatic upgrades for customers to 300 megs by mid-year. When internet is being used heavily by many people at the same time, the most it will lower to is to 220 megs (depending on time and number of users)
 - Charter Communications is looking to expand their services into the mobile field. Test are currently being done in Bakersfield.
 - Tec centers are in Irwindale and Azusa- if Duarte ever has any issues repair specialist are nearby.
 - Company Goal: make all new construction fiber-optic

- Program options for low income residents: Spectrum Internet Assist

 Qualifications: students enrolled in reduced/free lunch program can have high speed internet for\$14.99 per month*
 - -Qualifications for Seniors: Must be on SSI to get the \$14.99 monthly ${\rm rate}^*$
 - *Charter is the only company that offers this kind of program for such high-speed internet.
