RESOLUTION NO. 19-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUARTE, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE STOP SIGN POLICY

WHEREAS, the term "Stop Sign Policy" describes the comprehensive process, procedures, and criteria used when determining the installation of a stop sign; and

WHEREAS, the policy considers warrants for stop signs defined in the California Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD) including the volume of traffic, the volume of pedestrian, bicycle activity, high traffic speed, restricted sightlines, collision records, and unusual site conditions in the evaluation of all stop sign requests; and

WHEREAS, the policy can be applied to intersections without current stop controls or intersections that have only partial control; and

WHEREAS, the policy and procedures include an engineering study, engineering recommendation justification, staff approval or denial of stop sign request, presentation to the Duarte Traffic Safety Commission, presentation and recommended action to the Duarte City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the policy criteria for a stop sign or yield sign at an uncontrolled intersection in which Public Works staff exercises engineering judgement on a case-by case basis to determine the need for stop or yield sign based on which criteria and considerations are satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Stop Sign Policy criteria apply to the installation of stop signs at all approaches to an intersection that include minimum traffic volumes and speed, additional consideration for multi-way stops; and

WHEREAS, the process and procedures established in the City of Duarte Stop Sign Policy shall be enforced by the Director of Community Development and his or her representative; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUARTE, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves and adopts the "Stop Sign Policy" set forth in Attachment "A" to this Resolution, which describes the process, procedures, and criteria used when determining the installation of stop signs.
